

FAA Revokes Certificate Of YouTuber Who Crashed

Plane

The FAA has pulled the certificate of a California pilot and ex-Olympian who it says intentionally abandoned a vintage Taylorcraft and shot video of it crashing as he parachuted to the ground.

Trevor Jacob has been told to surrender his ticket immediately.... "Your flight ... [was] careless or reckless so as to endanger life or property of another," says the letter notifying him of the emergency revocation of the private certificate

- Jacob popped the door before the engine
- didn't issue a distress call or contact ATC, didn't try to restart the engine
- didn't try to land the aircraft on the many clear and flat areas seen in the video. FAA claims Jacob recovered the cameras and then disposed of the wreck.

MedXpress Tracking

FAA Introduces MedXPress Tracking

The FAA's agonizingly-slow medical certification process, especially for special issuance certificates, has been the cause of angst among pilots for years. All that is now in the past.

Effective April 15, new FAA MedXPress users were able to see the real-time status of their application. Those with applications prior to that date are able to see when new action is taken on their case.

The FAA said the changes to the MedXPress program are an attempt to be more transparent with the aviation community. "If you can track where your ridesharing car is or the status of a company delivering your package, pilots should be able to see online the real-time status of their application," said Federal Air Surgeon Dr. Susan Northern Linfortunately also added the page process will

REFRESHER CLINIC
Remember the "good old

days" of in-person FIRCs?

They're back!

The original CFI Flight Instructor Refresher Clinic was created in 1958 in the state of Montana. Then run by the FAA until 1967 when AOPA acquired and expanded this FAA program to a nationally-available option (originally three days). This program was the "gold standard" for in-person CFI renewal clinics until 2021 when ASI shut down in-person FIRCs as attendance declined and Covid ravaged the nation.

Good news! SAFE is resuscitating the AOPA ASI Inperson FIRCs. "We heard loud and clear from members that in-person was often a better educational experience," said SAFE executive director David St George, "so we've acquired ASI's inperson FIRC curriculum and hope to announce by this fall a 2023 schedule of FIRCs around the country."



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




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IFR VS VFR


- All IFR aircraft requesting multiple practice approaches will be advised to expect a full stop landing to the airport at which they were cleared.
- If an IFR aircraft cancels IFR on their own, multiple approaches can be afforded and VFR missed approach instructions will be given by the tower.


Common IFR/VFR issues:



- KMYF and KNKX are less than 3 miles apart.
 - Which means only one IFR a/c can depart at a time.
- KSDMVOR-A approach runs through two final approach courses (KMYF, KSAN), and three if you are north of KNKX.
- Also, the IFR missed approach turns towards KNZY RWY29 final approach course and crosses KSAN final approach course, if you follow it all the way to MZB.
- Because of the nature of IFR flight, it is crucial that ATC receives read backs in a timely manner.
 - If a student is having trouble on the radio, please step in sooner than later.

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BEST PRACTICES

- Do Not join any final approach unless you are in contact with ATC (Tower or Approach)
- Do not maneuver at altitudes that are near glide path or intercept altitudes.
- If you will be maneuvering near a VOR, Airway, Final Approach to an airport, please advise ATC. We will provide flight following, workload permitting.


BEST PRACTICES

- Right Altitude for direction as much as practical
- Class Bravo clearance: Advise ATC, as soon as possible, whether or not you need to use the Bravo.
 - Do not assume or expect clearance into the Bravo.
- Flight Instructors, step in when a read back is of higher priority.
 - PTAC (Position, Turn, Altitude, Clearance),
 - · Alerts, expedited clearances, etc.

- I want to thank GPA and the airport users for support in rolling out and completing the driver training program! We are moving in the right direction with the FAA and working toward a grant funded project for a western section of the Vehicle Service Road (VSR) between Allen Airways and the West Transient Ramp –
- We are hopeful to have this project funded in the fall or winter 2022.
- Eventually we will have a VSR on the north and south side of the airfield so we can eliminate runway crossings and comply with the FAA guidelines eliminating drivers from the movement area except for those that are tugging or servicing aircraft in the movement area
